The T-34's main gun could engage an enemy target at ranges between 1,000 and 2,000 meters. The 76 mm ZIS-5 had a maximum effective range of only 800 meters. The Tigers could also be equipped with the new ZIS-S-53P-1 anti-aircraft tank gun. The S-53P-1 had a maximum effective range of between 5,000 and 10,000 meters. The T-34 also carried a large number of anti-tank mines and armor-piercing shells. While the T-34 could outmaneuver the Tiger, the Tiger could outgun the T-34. The Tiger had a rate of fire of up to 60 rounds per minute, the T-34's rate of fire was about 30 rounds per minute. The Tiger was also faster than the T-34. The CBC's Greg Weston has released his CRTC investigation, which revealed that Canada's telecom companies have been misleading the CRTC for years about how they manage their networks. The CRTC said that it had found evidence of "systemic issues" at the largest telecom companies. The CRTC said that Canadian telecom companies had been hiring other companies to actually build, manage, and operate their networks.
