Aerosols in the human body can be defined broadly as any material that is directed into the body in some way. These can be divided between: E-cigarettes (Technically a complex mixture of nicotine, water and an aerosol buffer (a substance such as propylene glycol or polyethylene glycol)), which are widely available and by some estimates have more than two billion users. These are characterized by a liquid reservoir and heating device that atomizes a nicotine- and flavour-based aerosol. In the United States, secondhand smoke is known as environmental tobacco smoke, also known as passive smoking. Reactive chemicals that arise from tobacco combustion are detected in multiple body tissues. They are primarily released via the respiratory tract and enter the bloodstream when inhaled. Once in the bloodstream, they affect

cardiovascular, central nervous, hematologic, and reproductive systems. High concentrations of them have been found in amniotic fluid, umbilical cord blood, and colostrum and, while undetectable in the blood of newborn infants, they may cause toxicity through exposure during the fetal period. Up to six percent of all children may have adverse health effects if they are exposed to tobacco smoke in utero. People may also experience reactivity to the odor of smoke, even if no one is actually smoking. This is known as the smoker's illusion, and most likely it has an evolutionary basis, which may cause potential threats, such as rejection by potential mates or social ostracism.
