Clear-cut setup and accessibility via the systray Installing this utility is a swift task that shouldn't give you any trouble. Once launched, AutoTab creates an icon in the system tray area and sits there silently while running in the background, so it doesn't interrupt your normal PC activity by showing balloon messages. It can become active or inactive by just double-clicking the tray icon, and its status can be noticed by the color of the icon (green for active, red for inactive). Set the cycle time and minimize inactive windows As far as configuration settings are concerned, you can specify the time for cycling through all active windows (in seconds), ask the tool to minimize any opened windows you're not using anymore, as well as to run at every Windows startup until further notice. An important aspect worth noting is that the app works regardless of whether the user is idle or not. Evaluation and conclusion Unsurprisingly, it left a small footprint on system resources throughout our testing, thanks to the fact that it needed low CPU and RAM to work properly.
