Even if you do buy Photoshop, there are alternatives to consider. • Paint Brushes The Brush has three size options: Brush (1px), Pencil (2px), and Airbrush (16px). • Paint Over You can draw directly on the image and then build up the image using a soft eraser tool or a Paint Over. • Eraser The Eraser allows you to clean up, fix, and remove sections of an image. You can also use a Eraser to create a screen-print like effect. • Paths Paths let you draw closed shapes on an image that you can fill with color. • Stroke You can use Stroke (with a brush) or Stroke Path (with a Pencil) to create hand-drawn lines. • Gradient You can create a gradient, a gradual color change, with the Gradient tool. You can control the direction of the gradient and have multiple colors. • ReFill You can use the new ReFill tool to apply gradient, patterns, colors, and images to an area of an image. You can also use the ReFill tools to create texture or blur an area of an image. • Adjustment Layers When you edit an image, you can add an Adjustment Layer. You can then choose a filter to adjust the brightness or contrast of an entire image or an individual area. You can add an Adjustment Layer through the Window menu, the Layers panel, the Adjustment Layer panel, or Layer > New > Adjustment Layer. You can also use the Adjustment Panel.
